The numbers don't lie! Trialing an AAC device even just once has a significant impact on how comfortable SLPs feel working with high-tech AAC.

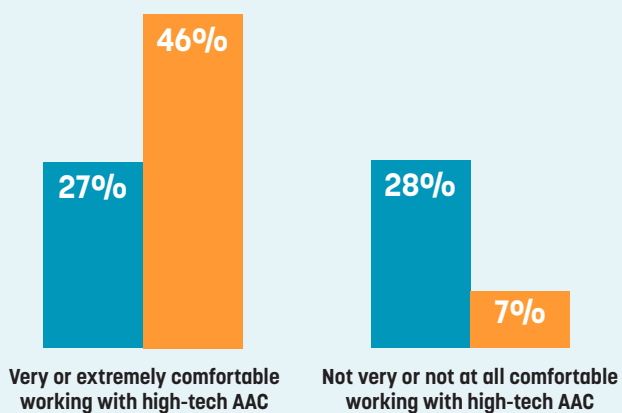

Comfort Levels with High-Tech AAC



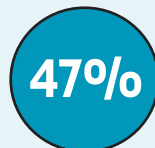
Understanding The Top AAC CHALLENGES

When asked about high-tech AAC and the biggest utilization challenges, SLPs point to some obstacles at higher rates than others.

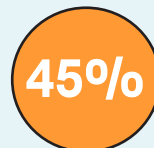
