

# Acquired Apraxia of Speech (AoS)

## 4 Informal Probes to Assess for AoS:



### Grapheme to Oral Positioning/Movement

Present a written phoneme and ask the individual to make the sound.



### Auditory-Grapheme Probe

Present a verbal phoneme and ask the individual to point to (or write) the sound.



Say "v"



Say "van"

### Imitative Probe

Model production and ask individual to imitate the phoneme in isolation and in a single word.



### Picture Probes

Present pictures of everyday objects and ask the individual to name them.

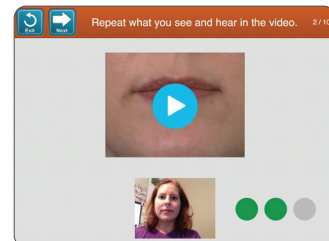
