#### 4 Informal Probes to Assess for AoS:





Grapheme to Oral Positioning/Movement Present a written phoneme and ask the individual to make the sound.

**Auditory-Grapheme Probe** Present a verbal phoneme and ask the individual to point to (or write) the sound.

Say "van"

**Imitative Probe** Model production and ask individual to imitate the phoneme in isolation and in a single word.




**Picture Probes** Present pictures of everyday objects and ask the individual to name them.
